This articulation agreement is between Middlesex Community Colleges and Walden University.

Middlesex Community Colleges (MSXCC) students who successfully complete courses in the Associate in Nursing program from the Lowell campus with a grade of *C* or better *and* meet the requirements for admission to Walden’s Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Completion Program or RN-BSN-MSN Program, may receive credit toward their degree. **All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.**

***Important Note:** Courses indicated on these tables will be fulfilled, but there may be outstanding credit. Walden requires that 45 of the last 90 quarter credits earned for a bachelor’s degree be earned at Walden University. Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.*
